

<p><b>magnificent</b> (Test B)</p>	<p>years 5 and 6 statutory requirement: words ending in <b>-ant</b>, <b>-ance/-ancy</b>, <b>-ent</b>, <b>-ence/-ency</b></p>	
<p><b>Correct</b></p>	<p>44%</p>	
<p><b>Common error</b></p>	<p>19% = error with ending <b>-ent</b> Pupils who misspelt <i>magnificent</i> tended to make errors in the spelling of the word ending <b>-ent</b> (<i>magnificant</i>). Some pupils made an additional error with the unusual correspondence with letter <b>c</b> (<i>magnifisant</i>).</p>	
<p><b>Other words</b></p>	<p>ending <b>-ent</b></p> <p><i>absent</i> <i>continent</i> <i>ingredient</i></p>	<p>with unusual correspondence with letter <b>c</b> in addition to <b>-ent</b> ending</p> <p><i>innocent</i> <i>recent</i></p>
